Motor Neurone Disease (MND) is a progressive neurological disease. MND affects approximately 1400 people in Australia at any given time and their carers, families and friends live daily with its impact. On average every day in Australia at least one person dies from MND and another is diagnosed. CareSearch would like to recognise [MND week](#) which takes place on May 2-8.
