**Study Title: Evaluation of the Palliative Care Needs Assessment intervention**

**Brief description of the study:**

This study is part of a program of work that will improve patient-centred care and need-based utilisation of SPC services in Australia. Whilst specialist palliative care can improve outcomes for people with a life limiting illness and their families, access is variable and does not always reflect unmet need. We will trial whether an intervention that promotes regular palliative care needs assessment results in a better match between the levels of needs of patients with advanced cancer and their caregivers and their service utilisation. Participants' self-reported unmet needs and wellbeing will be assessed over a 15-month period (or until the patient dies) and bereavement outcomes will be assessed for caregivers 6 months following the death of the patient (if during study period).
