Study Title: Toward the identification and minimisation of depression and psychological distress in family caregivers of people receiving palliative care

Brief description of the study:

Palliative Care is holistic, patient and family centred care provided for dying people and their families, before, during and after death. It acknowledges dying as a physical, psychological, social, spiritual and cultural process that is experienced uniquely by each person and family. Palliative care services are involved in the care of patients and families who are distressed, or who are at risk of being distressed as a consequence of this process (*Palliative Care Australia - Standards for Palliative Care Provision, 1999*). Currently the evidence base for preventing, assessing and responding to depression, anxiety and prolonged grief in family caregivers of people receiving palliative care at home is suboptimal. As family caregivers comprise a significant section of the Australian population this is seen as an area that has been overlooked. This 3 year longitudinal study will have two stages. The first stage of this project seeks to evaluate a strategy designed to more effectively screen family caregivers of people with advanced disease (such as cancer) for mental health problems. The second stage seeks to develop best practice guidelines for health professionals in order to better respond to and minimise depression and psychological distress in this population.
