| 90051 | <p>Level D consultation (≥ 40 mins)</p> <p>Attendance by GP at a RACF for taking an extensive patient history; performing a clinical examination; arranging any necessary investigation; implementing a management plan; providing appropriate preventive health care; for one or more health-related issues, with appropriate documentation.</p> <p>After hours: item 5067.</p> | \$122.15 |
| 90054 | <p>Level E consultation (≥ 60 mins)</p> <p>Attendance by GP at a RACF for managing care needs of patients with chronic conditions, those in need of advance care planning, palliative care and end-of-life care, and patients needing additional time for proper communications, e.g., patients with dementia, various disabilities, or where an interpreter is required.</p> <p>After hours: item 5077.</p> | \$197.90 |
| Comprehensive medical assessment | | |
| 701 | <p>Brief health assessment (< 30 mins)</p> <p>For simple health assessments including a basic physical examination.</p> | \$67.60 |
| 703 | <p>Standard health assessment (30-45 mins)</p> <p>For straightforward assessments where a resident does not present with complex health issues but may require more attention than can be provided in a brief assessment.</p> | \$157.10 |

| 705 | Long health assessment (45-60 mins) For an extensive assessment, where the resident has a range of health issues that require more in-depth consideration, and longer-term strategies for managing the resident's health may be necessary. Might be used to introduce a discussion about advance care planning or palliative care. | \$216.80 |
| 707 | Prolonged health assessment (> 60 mins) May include an extensive examination of the resident's medical condition, and physical, psychological, and social function. Could be used to introduce a discussion about advance care planning or palliative care. | \$306.25 |
| 731 | Multidisciplinary care plan in a residential aged care facility GP contribution to or review of a multidisciplinary care plan prepared by a residential aged care facility. | \$80.20 |
| GP multidisciplinary case conferences | | |
| 735 | Case conference (15-20 mins) For organising, coordinating, and participating in a multidisciplinary case conference in a residential aged care facility. For participating only in a case conference of this duration, see 747 . | \$80.55 |
| 739 | Case conference (20-40 mins) For organising, coordinating, and participating in a multidisciplinary case conference in a residential aged care facility. Provides an opportunity for an holistic informed approach to ongoing care for providers, carers and family. For participating only in a case conference of this duration, see 750 . | \$137.75 |
| 743 | Case conference (>40 mins) For organising, coordinating, and participating in a multidisciplinary case conference in a residential aged care facility. For participating only in a case conference of this duration, see 758 . | \$229.65 |
| Medication review | | |
| 903 | Residential medication management review (RMMR) Participation by a GP in a medication management review for someone in a residential aged care facility. Candidates for this review include residents for whom quality use of medicines may be an issue, or those at risk of medication misadventure due to a significant change in their condition or medication regimen. | \$120.80 |
