<u>701</u>	Brief health assessment (< 30 mins)  For simple health assessments including a basic physical examination.	\$67.60

<u>707</u>	Prolonged health assessment (> 60 mins)	\$306.25
	May include an extensive examination of the resident's medical condition, and physical, psychological, and social function. Could be used to introduce a discussion about advance care planning or palliative care.	
<u>731</u>	Multidisciplinary care plan in a residential aged care facility	\$80.20
	GP contribution to or review of a multidisciplinary care plan prepared by a residential aged care facility.

	For organising, coordinating, and participating in a multidisciplinary case conference in a residential aged care facility.

	For organising, coordinating, and participating in a multidisciplinary case conference in a residential aged care facility. Provides an opportunity for an holistic informed approach to ongoing care for providers, carers and family.
