<u>705</u>	Long health assessment (45-60 mins)	\$216.80		
	For an extensive assessment, where the patient has a range of health issues that require more in-depth consideration, and longer-term strategies for managing the patient's health may be necessary. Might be used to introduce a discussion about advance care planning or palliative care.			
<u>707</u>	Prolonged health assessment (> 60 mins)  May include an extensive examination of the patient's medical condition, and physical, psychological, and social function. Could be used to introduce a discussion about advance care planning or palliative care.	\$306.25
